On April 30, 2024, The South-Central Ohio Major Crimes Unit, with the assistance of the Lancaster Police Department, and the Fairfield County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at 4970 Delmont Rd. Lancaster after an investigation involving drug trafficking. A search of a camper located on the property resulted in the seizure of more than 220 grams of Methamphetamine, 15 grams of Fentanyl, prescription drugs, \$718 in cash, and a .380 caliber handgun.



Shay Marie Browning, 33, was arrested on a probation violation and transported to the Fairfield County Jail.

Additional charges from the investigation will be presented to the Fairfield County Prosecutors Office at a later date.

This type of successful outcome which directly impacts the quality of life in our community, is the result of a collaborative effort between the South-Central Ohio Major Crimes Unit, its Law Enforcement partners, and the community.
